



2021 CALGARY YOUTH SCIENCE FAIR RULES and INSTRUCTIONS

MUST BE READ AND UNDERSTOOD BEFORE SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM

1. If your entry involves the study of live animals, including humans, or use of animal tissue, you must fill out the *Ethics and Due Care Form (2A)* and send it in *before beginning your project*. Additionally, if you determine after filling out Form 2A, that your project involves significant risk, you will need Form 2B as well.
2. If your entry involves surveys or otherwise uses human subjects, each person in your study must read and sign an *Informed Consent Form (2C)*. These forms should be kept in your Log Book.
3. Questions regarding any aspect of the fair should be directed to your *SCHOOL COORDINATOR*.
4. Entries are limited to *GRADE 5 & ABOVE*.
5. An individual may be involved in only one project.
6. Group projects may consist of only *TWO STUDENTS*.
7. No project previously entered in Calgary Youth Science Fair may be re-entered unless it has been drastically modified.
8. Your project must comply with Ethics and Safety Regulations which can be viewed online at cysf.org. You and your parents must confirm these have been read, and understood by signing the entry form.
9. The society reserves the right to disqualify, or expel from the fair, any project that has breached the rules, safety regulations, animal use guidelines or includes plagiarism.
